A Social Work England-registered social worker, you will support our service by ensuring your work is always delivered with the best interests of the children we support at the heart - in line with Diagrama's values and ethos and in compliance with legislation, regulation, national standards, guidance and best practice.

You will support adopters and foster carers of all backgrounds regardless of faith, sexuality or ethnicity.

In adoption, we focus on finding new parents for priority children, those who have been waiting the longest, and often have additional needs.

In fostering, we are seeking to ensure the quality of foster carers we support and approve meets the changing needs of the children we care for. We place the needs and safeguarding of the child at the heart of our service and seek for the them to achieve in all areas of their lives.

As an ISW you will report to one of our team managers and undertake assessments in line with the updated Coram/BAAF Competency Framework.



You will work in collaboration with Diagrama to assess potential adopters and/or foster carers through to the point of presenting to Diagrama's Independent Joint Adoption and Fostering Panel.

You will be passionate about recruiting and assessing adopters and foster carers, focusing on evidencing skills to support matching of children's needs including; diversity, abilities, love and understanding of trauma. You may be also be invited to participate in training and recruitment events.

Due to the nature of this role you will be expected to work some weekends and evenings as necessary.
